

Salisbury Rovers FC Membership & Payments Policy



Membership

A member of the Club is:

- a player who has signed a Club membership form and is paying subscriptions (see below);
- an appointed member of the Committee; or
- for the purposes of the Club's disciplinary or complaints procedures, members shall also include the parents or guardians of players who are members.

A register of Club members shall be kept by the Club membership secretary.

Only members of the Club may play for Salisbury Rovers' teams. Any kit given to a member remains the property of the Club and must be returned if the member leaves or fails to make payment of their subscription fees (see below).

A member wishing to resign shall give notice to this effect in writing to the team manager concerned or an officer of the club, such notice to be accompanied by payment of all club dues at that date.

Payment

Subscriptions will be set at a level by the Committee which covers the costs of: league registration fees for teams, limited insurance cover, pitch fees, coach fees, footballs and training equipment. Salisbury Rovers FC may also request additional subscriptions for special training or other events.

The Club will accept payment of subscription fees via the following methods below:

1. cheque or bank transfer: full payment of £120.
2. twice yearly payments of £60 every six months.
3. a standing order (or bank transfer) established to pay £10 every month (before 5th month) for 12 months of the year.
4. an alternative payment plan agreed with the Club.

Non-payment of subscriptions

In the event of non-payment of due subscriptions for **two months**, membership will be deemed to be terminated and any kit must be returned.

A player shall not then be eligible to participate in any further Club sessions or matches until the outstanding amount has been collected.

However, every effort will be made to discuss this with the relevant parties before action is taken.

We are committed to ensuring that no child is 'priced out' of football. In the case of financial hardship, we would ask parents/carers to contact us immediately and complete an application for an alternative payment scheme (see below).

Special Circumstances

The Committee will only accept requests for a different payment scheme if these are made in writing on the appropriate form and sent to the Club Secretary. The reasons for the request must be set out on the form. Documentary evidence of the special circumstances will be requested.

A decision will be made by the committee who will confirm in writing the outcome. Personal information will be removed from the application to the committee and the identity of the child will be kept confidential.

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
